In your Standalone or Laravel app

Updating Mixpost is a simple task that can be executed in a few steps. This guide will provide you with the necessary steps to update Mixpost.

```
composer update inovector/mixpost
```

After the update is complete, clear the cache by running the following command:

```
php artisan cache:clear
```

Next, publish the assets:

```
php artisan mixpost:publish-assets
```

Finally, terminate the Horizon process by running:

```
php artisan horizon:terminate
```

This all!

You can check the version of Mixpost by running the command:

```
composer show inovector/mixpost
```

Update with Docker

Updating Mixpost with Docker is straightforward, you just make sure to preserve the mounted volume. Just pull the latest image, stop and remove the current container, and then start a new one.

Navigate to your folder where you have the `docker-compose.yml` the file then run:

```
# Pull the latest version
docker-compose pull

# Stop and remove the old container
docker-compose down

# Start a new container
docker-compose up -d
```
