

Cron

Add a cron that runs the scheduler every minute:

```
* * * * * cd /path-to-your-project && php artisan schedule:run >> /dev/null 2>&1
```

Plesk

In Plesk, the command will look something like:

```
cd /var/www/vhosts/domain/httpdocs/ && php artisan schedule:run >> /dev/null 2>&1
```

Replace "**domain**" with your real domain.

Make sure to set the "Run" to "Cron Style" and insert:

```
* * * * *
```
