

Installing & Configuring Supervisor

Installing Supervisor

You need to configure a process monitor. To install Supervisor on Ubuntu, you may use the following command:

```
sudo apt-get install supervisor
```

Configuring Supervisor

Supervisor configuration files are typically stored in the `/etc/supervisor/conf.d`.

Create the file `mixpost-horizon.conf` inside of `conf.d` folder and put this configuration content:

```
[program: mixpost_horizon]
process_name=%(program_name)s
command=php /path-to-your-project/artisan horizon
autostart=true
autorestart=true
user=your_user_name
stopwaitsecs=3600
```

Once the configuration file has been created, you may update the Supervisor configuration and start the processes using the following commands:

```
sudo supervisorctl reread

sudo supervisorctl update

sudo supervisorctl start mixpost_horizon:*
```
